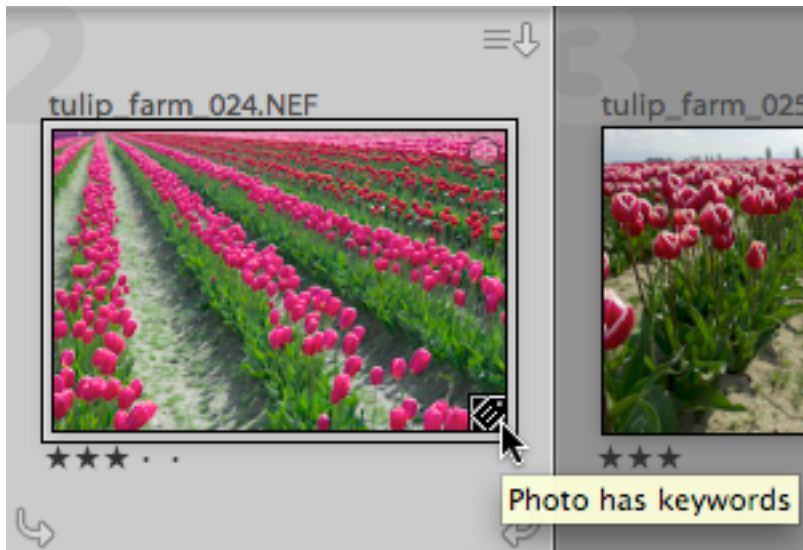


## Lightroom Keywords

I certainly recommended that the major heavy lifting for keywords be applied during the import process when the information is fresh. When ingesting images into a Library / Catalog I will take the time to identify words that can be used to describe the location, the object , the person etc.

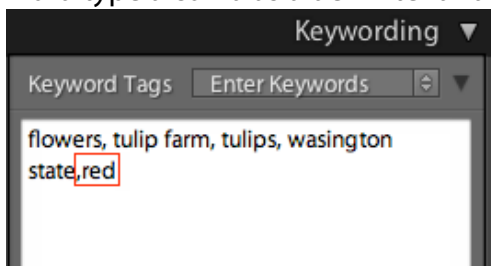
Finding images in your library will be uncomplicated if you maintain a structure and an approach that allows for searching with keywords.

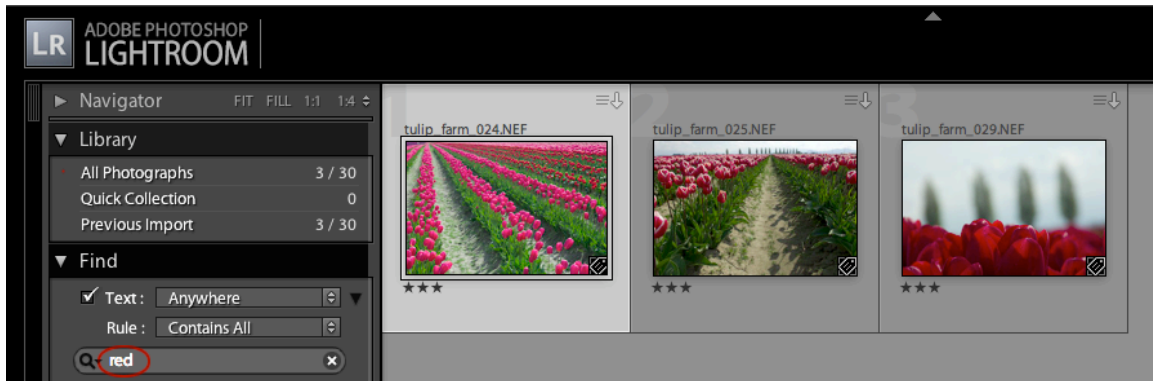


In the **Grid** mode the little badge on the lower right hand corner indicates that the image already has keywords applied.

In this case I would like to add the word "red " to help narrow future additional searches by keyword(s). I can add this word to a single image or many images at the same time.

Highlight the image(s) in the Grid mode. Navigate to the right panel header Keywording, the display tells me what keywords are already applied. To add another word type a coma as a delimiter and type the word in the field under Enter Keywords





To find all images within the Library / Catalog with the keyword "red" go to the left hand side panel "Find " and type in the word red . The three images that have the word red in this catalog will be displayed in the Grid.
